

I-Ting Huang

Violist I-Ting Huang, a native of Taiwan, is the top winner of all instrumental concerto competition at the Taipei National University of the Arts, National Taiwan Viola and Chamber Music (as a pianist) Competitions in Taiwan. Beginning her piano studies at age 2 and half, she decided to engage on viola at age 17. As a full scholarship recipient and sponsored by LCU Foundation, she studied with renowned violist Hsin-Yun Huang at Mannes College of Music in New York on Master and PSD degree; and earned her DMA degree in UMKC conservatory in 2013, under the tutelage of Benny Kim and Scott Lee. I-Ting had invited to collaborate with Orion String Quartet, Benny Kim, Nina Beilina on chamber music concerts past years. She has participated and performed in prestigious music festivals including Schleswig-Holstein, Prague Spring, Pacific Music Festival, Kneisel Hall, Moscow Conservatory Summer School; and has also presented in solo master classes given by Nubuko Imai, Paul Neubauer, Bruno Giurana, Lawrence Dutton, Roberto Diaz, Donald McInnes and in chamber by Borromeo, Miró, Emerson, and Juilliard String Quartet. She has been enjoying performing and teaching, currently moves to LA area and residents with her husband in Pasadena.
